ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACT OF LITTERING AND PRESCRIBING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cooke, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

1. No person, firm, corporation or association shall throw, or drop, or cause to be thrown or dropped upon any road or other public place or upon the land of another, any garbage, bottles, waste paper, cans, cartons, wire, metal, glass, boxes of any kind, discarded or soiled personal property, trash or rubbish of any kind within this Township.

2. Any person or persons violating this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, before a District Justice, pay a fine of not less than One Hundred, Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars or on default thereof be imprisoned in the Cumberland County Prison for not more than thirty (30) days or both.

3. Any Ordinance or part of Ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed insofar as it is inconsistent herewith.
