

Ordinance No. 7

AN ORDINANCE OF COOKE TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING WEIGHT LIMITS FOR VEHICLE ON ALL TOWNSHIP ROADS; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Cooke Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1 No motor vehicle or other type vehicle shall be operated, or in any other manner used, upon any of the roads of Cooke Township, if the gross weight of such motor vehicle or other type vehicle and its load shall exceed 15 tons.

SECTION 2 All such roads shall be marked at the beginning and the end of such roads and at such other points as shall give notice of said weight limits to any person entering said Township roads from any other highway.

SECTION 3 The determination of the weight of said motor vehicle or type of vehicle for the purposes of this Ordinance shall be the combined weight of all units being operated or used as a unit.

SECTION 4 Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before any Justice-of-the-Peace within Cooke Township, be sentenced to pay the cost of prosecution, a fine not exceeding Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, and in default thereof be sentenced to imprisonment in the Cumberland County Prison for not more than Thirty (30) days.
